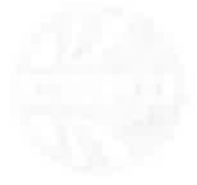

**RESOLUTION FOR THE CITY OF BELTON TO PARTICIPATE IN A JOINT REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY REGARDING A POTENTIAL CONSOLIDATION OF CITY FIRE SERVICES AND DISTRICT FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES INCLUDING EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES WITH THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW, MOUNT PLEASANT FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, SOUTH METRO FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, WEST PECULIAR FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AND WESTERN CASS FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, WITH THE CITY OF BELTON SERVING AS THE COORDINATING AGENCY FOR THE PROPOSAL.**

**WHEREAS**, there are many potential benefits to consolidation of resources and assets among multiple fire protection services including access to trained staff, regional service planning and delivery, reduction of duplicate expenditures and cost savings; and

**WHEREAS**, a feasibility study will address each community's need for service, desired level of service, customer perception of emergency services, support for a consolidated emergency services system, along with general input; and

**WHEREAS**, the result of a feasibility study will assist in determining whether or not an initiative petition process for placement on a future ballot is recommended; and

**WHEREAS**, the interested agencies represent the contiguous tracts or parcels of property containing all or parts of the area in which there is a need for fire protection services benefitting the citizens within the designated areas; and,

**WHEREAS**, the law permitting formation of consolidated Fire Protection Districts results from citizens feeling they need a higher level of protection across a broader range of area resulting in better coverage and services to all citizens within a proposed District area; and,

**WHEREAS**, once the agencies receive the responses to the Request for Proposal and desire to move forward with a consultant, the agencies will negotiate a memorandum of understanding reflecting common goals, coordinating the scope of work and finalizing payment allocation; and

**WHEREAS**, the agencies have secured an estimate of \$80,000 for a feasibility study and suggest a payment allocation to share the costs of the feasibility study based upon a cost share formula including average percentages of call volume, population, square miles, and assessed valuation; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council believes it is in the best interests of the citizens of Belton to authorize a joint Request for Proposal to solicit qualified consultants to conduct a feasibility study as described herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Belton, Missouri as follows:

**Section 1.** That the City of Belton shall participate in and coordinate a joint Request for Proposal to solicit qualified consultants to conduct a feasibility study for potential consolidation of City Fire Services and Fire Protection Districts including Emergency Medical Services with the City of Grandview, Mount Pleasant Fire Protection District, South Metro Fire Protection District, West Peculiar Fire Protection District and Western Cass Fire Protection District.

**Section 2.** That this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
