

Water Services Division Utility Worker

The City of Belton, Public Works Department - Water Services Division is looking for an experienced, high-performing individual for the Utility Worker position.

Job duties include, but not limited to:

GENERAL PURPOSE:

Under general supervision, performs skilled cleaning, repair, inspection, and maintenance work of the City's water and sewer system and lift and pump stations; operates a variety of equipment in the construction, repair, maintenance, and replacement of City water and wastewater facilities and systems; and maintains and repairs the water and treatment plant facility and fixtures as needed/required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Education and Experience: High School Diploma/GED required. Six months experience in the operation of water and/or wastewater collections systems or the operation of a variety of construction equipment related to water/wastewater maintenance and construction work is preferred; OR an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience.

Required Licenses or Certifications: Possession of a valid Class B State Commercial Driver License with air brakes is preferred or must be obtained within six months of employment. Other licenses/certifications such as Distribution System Operator III License and/or Class D wastewater certification are preferred or must be obtained within 3 years of employment.
